Up to 10 videos with the most votes will move on to the last round and be asked to submit a 200 word essay explaining what it means to be a part of the fire service or a fire service family member, which post high school studies they wish to pursue and how the award will help them achieve those goals.

The contest is open to US residents who are at least 16 years of age at the start date of the contest and who plan on attending a post high school education during 2012-2013 at an institution such as a community college, university or vocational school. **The winner must be related to an Arizona Fire Fighter or Fire Service employee.**
